INTERIM JOINT MATRICULATION BOARD EXAMINATION 2024
INSTRUCTIONS TO SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES FOR PAPER III CHEMISTRY PRACTICAL
(ALTERNATVE A)

Q1. Make available to your students the following materials:

- a) Prepare Solution A by transferring 26 g of sodium thiosulphate pentahydrate, Na₂S₂O_{3.5}H₂O to 1dm³ volumetric flask containing about 500cm³ distilled water. Swirl the flask to dissolve the compound completely. Add more distilled water to make up the solution to the mark. Each student should be provided with about 100cm³ of this solution.
- b) Prepare Solution B by transferring 4g of potassium tetraoxomanganate(VII), KMnO₄ to 1dm³ volumetric flask containing about 600cm³ distilled water. Swirl the flask to dissolve the compound completely. Add more distilled water to make up the solution to the mark. Each student should be provided with about 170cm³ of this solution.
- c) Prepare Solution C by transferring 100g of potassium iodide, KI to 1dm³ volumetric flask containing about 700cm³ distilled water. Swirl the flask to dissolve the compound completely. Add more distilled water to make up the solution to the mark. Each student should be provided with about 40cm³ of this solution.
- d) Prepare a fresh solution D (indicator) by making a paste of 1g of soluble starch in a small quantity of distilled water, and add about 100cm³ of boiling water. Boil the mixture to obtain a clear solution. This should be within the reach of every student.
- e) Prepare Solution E by transferring 40g of Ammonium ferrous sulphate hexahydrate, (NH₄)₂SO₄FeSO₄.6H₂O in to 350cm³ conical flask containing about 400 cm³ of distilled water. Add to the resulting solution about 10 cm³ of concentrated tetraoxosulphate(VI) acid, H₂SO₄. Swirl the flask to dissolve the compound completely. Transfer the solution quantitatively to 1 dm³ volumetric flask and add more distilled water to make up the solution to the mark. Each student should be provided with about 110cm³ of this solution.
- f) Prepare Solution F by transferring 110 cm³ of concentrated tetraoxosulphate(VI) acid, H₂SO₄ (98% w/w, specific gravity 1.80) in to 1dm³ volumetric flask containing about 500cm³ distilled water. Allow the solution to cool and gradually make it up to mark with distilled water. Each student should be provided with about 160cm³ of this solution.

Measuring cylinder (of capacity 10 or 20 cm³) in addition to other titration materials.
